The Committee is pleased to announce that the CEO exam has been updated and will use the CAR Purchase Agreement in the problem portion of the exam. The CSEO test is also being updated and should be completed by the end of the year. A big thank you to Shauna Rushing for all of her hard work on the CEO exam and Lynn Yockey for her efforts on the CSEO exam.

The Committee asks that anyone attending this year's conference and has had an issue with the scan in/scan out system and would like a paper confirmation to please contact Deb Perry, CEA President at debperrym@yahoo.com for assistance.

All PD Holders must scan in and scan out for each education they attend. You are allotted a 10 minute window – if you scan in 10 minutes after the session has started or scan out more than 10 minutes after the session has ended – you will not receive the CEU for the session.

For example, Jane scans in at 8:08 am for an 8:00 am session and then scans out at 8:57 am for the same session that ends at 9:00 am. This reflects an eleven (11) minute absence from the session, therefore, the scan is not valid and no CEU will be issued.

When you scan in or out, you should hear a beep, the red light on the scanner will turn green and your card number will appear on the monitor. If you do not believe the scanner read your card, ask the attendant for confirmation. The Red Coats are there to assist you.

In addition, this year at Conference the Monitor's will be placing a large, red sign indicating that the session has passed the 10 minute mark and CEU's will not be issued if you sign in.

After much discussion a motion was passed that CEA will grant double credits for all CEA sponsored education at Conference and Regional meetings. The double credits are not in effect for:

- * Notary class and test
- * PD testing and proctors
- * Instructors / Speakers
- * CEI requirement to verify three (3) hours of teaching in the three-year PD cycle
